ACCREDITATION EXPLANATION

The Circuit of Ireland International Rally, the 3rd round of the IRC Rally Championship, has to apply to strict criteria for media. Please read the following guidelines carefully and make sure all the information requested is supplied with your accreditation application.

Failure to supply the requested information, or to sign the disclaimer, will delay the processing of your application.

ACCREDITATION GUIDELINES

- A maximum of three (3) representatives per organisation will be considered for accreditation. A separate application form should be submitted for each person to be accredited.
- To be accredited, a publication must have a circulation size and quality that satisfies the criteria of the IRC.

INFORMATION TO BE SUPPLIED WITH EACH APPLICATION:

Press and journalist accreditation:

- A formal request for accreditation written on the publication's official letterhead, signed by the Chief Editor or senior member of the editorial staff. Requests signed by clerical staff will not be accepted.
- Written confirmation of the publication's frequency and circulation or readership figures
- A photocopy of the official national press card (where applicable) of the representative who will be covering the event
- A current and original copy of the publication
- A completed accreditation form (see page 2)

TV, camera crew and radio information

- Information for TV or camera crews: Channel, purpose of the footage, duration and broadcast time of the program
- A completed accreditation form (see page 2)
- A photocopy of the official national press card (where applicable) of the representative who will be covering the event

Once applications have been processed by the Circuit of Ireland International Rally Media Team and approved by Eurosport Events, an email confirming successful accreditation will be sent to the applicant(s)

This email must be produced when collecting passes at the event.

No passes will be issued without this confirmation email.
